#### ARRIVAL IN LIMA, VISIT TO THE MAGIC WATER CIRCUIT AND DINNER SHOW

Upon arrival at the Lima's Jorge Chavez Airport, our driver and guide will be waiting for you and transfer to your chosen hotel in Miraflores, the best place to stay at the Lima city. Depending on the arrival time, you may rest or go for a walk. At 1800 p.m. we will pick you up to begin the by night tour; starting with the visit Parque de la Reserva, where the largest set of colored fountains in the world are located. You will have time to tour the famous Magic Water Circuit and, of course, to admire the beautiful spectacle that is projected on the main fountain, with a play of lights, colors and music. At the end of the visit we will take you to an exquisite restaurant, so you can enjoy a dinner with authentic Peruvian flavors, along with a folkloric show. After that we will return to your hotel.

#### CITY TOUR AND DINNER AT THE HUACA PUCLLANA

After breakfast we will pick you up at your hotel for a city tour of Lima; its historic center will surprise you with its beautiful buildings and, we will arrive at the Plaza de Armas, to visit the Cathedral, built between 1542 and 1622. Later we will visit Casa Aliaga, a residence built in the sixteenth century for the family of Captain Jerónimo de Aliaga. Many centuries have passed, but in this place the family still lives, who have decided to open part of their house to the general public, to share with them the history. Then we will visit the Larco Museum, built inside a mansion built during the viceroyalty on a pre-Columbian pyramid of the seventh century. In it you can see an exhibition of gold and silver pieces, in addition to the famous collection of erotic art that characterizes it. At the end of the city tour we will take you back to your hotel, so that you can rest, because at night we will pick you up again to take you to dinner at the huaca Pucllana restaurant. Immersed in the residential neighborhood of Miraflores, this archaeological complex was built more than 1,500 years ago and you can enjoy its beautiful views while tasting exquisite dishes of Creole cuisine. Once dinner is over we will take you back to your hotel.

Our excursion begins with a panoramic view of the "Pucllana Pyramid", built in the fourth century AD and considered "sacred town" by the Incas. Afterwards we'll head 30 Km south of Lima to the ORACLE OF PACHACAMAC, the visit to the splendid Citadel of Pachacamac, Sanctuary of the God Pachacamac, creator of the Universe for the ancient Andean peoples, will lead you to the believes of the Quechua race. The citadel comprises temples, pyramids and palaces. Highlights include the Temple of the Sun, the Temple of Pachacamac, the "Acllahuasi" or Palace of the Virgins of the Sun, among others. The whole place was considered sacred and part of the mystical axis of the world; returning you visit an "hacienda", of Peruvian Paso Horse. Our tour takes a break at the D' Paso, located in Mamacona. In its beautiful gardens, an Amazon or a Chalán will invite you to know the world of the Peruvian Paso horse with the stories of this noble animal. You will enjoy a Pisco Sour cocktail at the start of the exhibition. The show presents the various stages of preparation and care of this Peruvian breed. Riders will surprise you with the dominance of this horses. The high moment of the show is when the formation of Chalanés and the Amazons dances the Marinera. After the show the table is served with a buffet lunch.

At the agreed time, according to the departure of your flight, we will transfer to the Jorge Chávez International Airport in order to take your flight to home, or the next step of your journey.

## Day 1

**0330 AM**

Transfer to the Cruz del Sur bus terminal; departure to Paracas at some 240 KM south of Lima; the trip duration are some 4 hours. Arrival in Paracas, transfer to the touristic pier and embark for the sail to the Ballestas Islands; on the sail to the Islands sight of the Candelabra, a unique and mysterious giant figure pointing to the South with still unknown origin. The sail on the island is for about 2 hours; return to Paracas and transfer to the hotel. After check in at the Hotel front-desk, next will begin the excursion to the to the Paracas National Reserve and the Paracas Interpretation Center with the small site Museum; the beaches of Lagunillas and La Mina. Overnight.

## Day 2

**0830 AM**

After breakfast transfer to the bus station; departure to Ica by bus service, some 1 hour drive. At arrival in Ica, meeting and immediately begin the sightseeing tour covering: the Regional Museum, a tasting visit to a local vineyard; next is the Huacachina Lagoon and the sand-boogies tour on the upper dunes, sanboarding is included for the adventurous. At 15.30 transfer by bus to the city of Nazca, some 2hrs.30 minutes. Arrival in Nazca and transfer to your hotel. At 21 hours meeting with the Chaman Félix and departure to the Energetic Center of Orcona tour, the tour begins with a Chacra cleaning, and a ceremony to the Pachamama, next is the energy transfer finally an explanation of the constellations in the Southern Hemisphere and the theories about the Nazca Lines.

## Day 3

**09:00 AM**

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airfield where you will aboard the high-wing aircraft for a flight of approximate 35 minutes over the most enigmatic Lines of the World. Return to hotel. Free time for leisure.

**14:00 PM**

Transfer to the bus station. 14.30. pm depart to Lima by Cruz del Sur. (Driving time, some 7 hours). Arrival, meeting and transfer to your hotel.



## Day 1

**0620 AM**

Transfer to the bus station; departure by Cruz del Sur or Exclusiva buses to Ica, some 5 hours drive, at 300 KM South of Lima.

After arrival transfer to the Ica airfield where you will aboard the Cessna Caravan aircraft and take-off to Nazca for an almost 1 hour and 30 minutes flight to overflight the most enigmatic Lines on planet Earth, the Nazca Lines. You don't land in Nazca; after the overflight you will return to Ica and after landing will start the tour visiting the artisanal vineyards, the Regional Museum, the Oasis of Huacachina and the do the boogies tour over the upper sand dunes. At 19:00 return to Paracas, arrival and transfer to the Hotel.

## Day 2

**07:30 AM**

After breakfast transfer to the touristic pier and embark for the sail to the Ballestas Islands; on the sail to the Islands sight of the Candelabra, a unique and mysterious giant figure with a shape of an stylized figure of a Candelabra, pointing to the South. The sail to the islands is for about 2 hours; return to Paracas. Free time for lunch.

At 16:00 transfer to the bus station, return by bus to the city of Lima. Transfer to your Hotel.

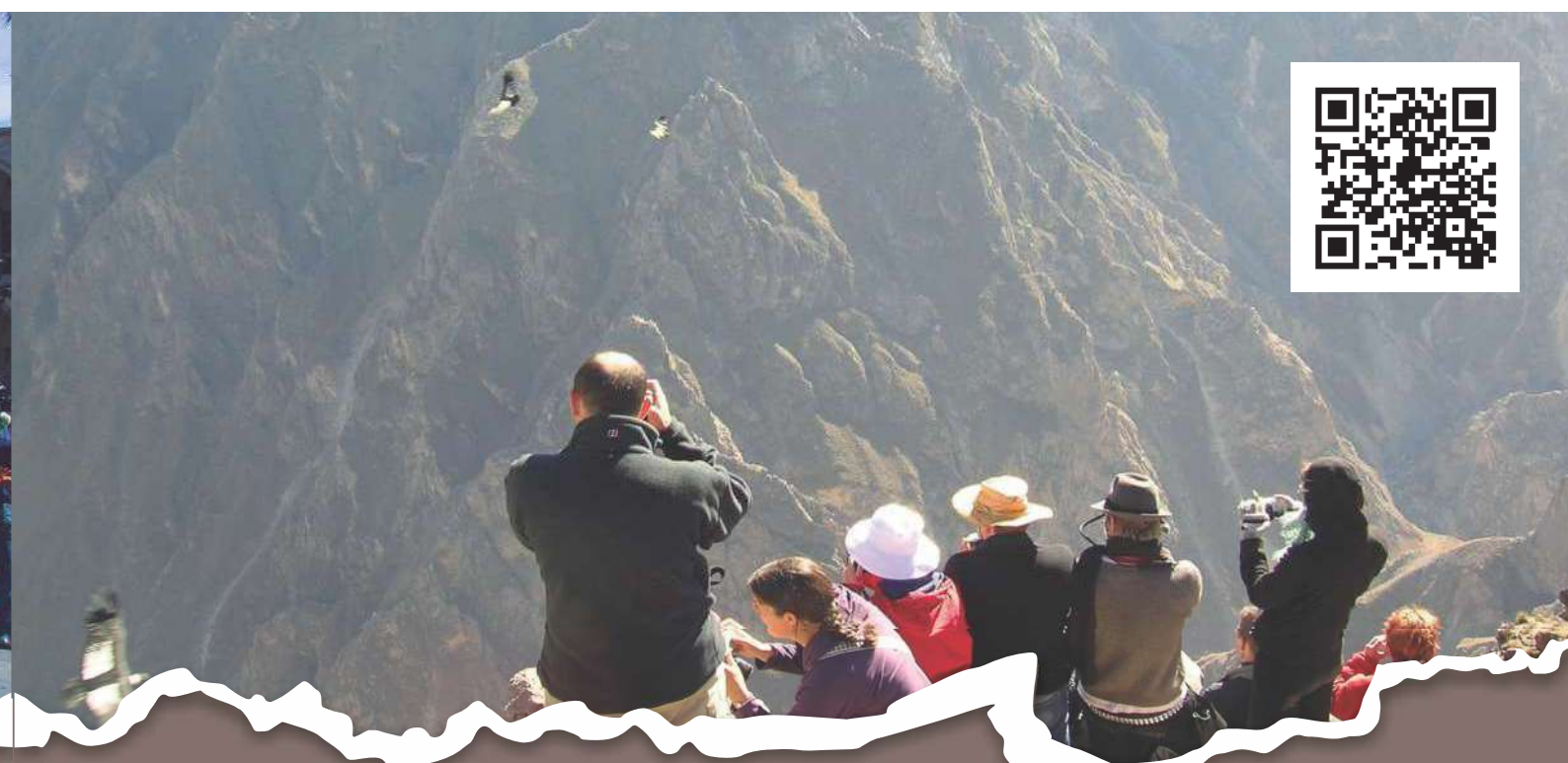
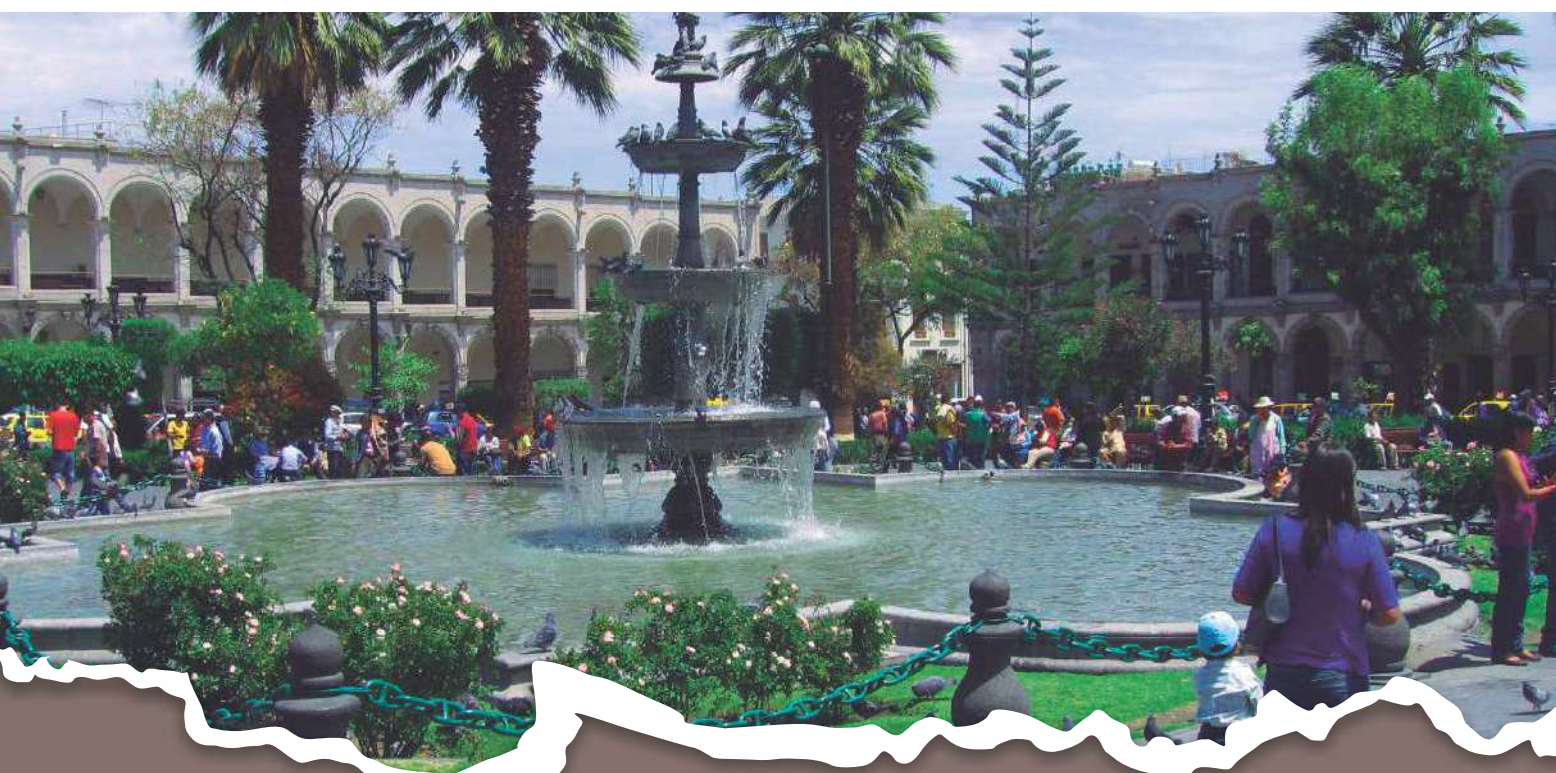

## Day 1

### CITY TOUR

The tour start driving towards to the district of Cayma, one of Arequipa's traditional districts. In Cayma we will visit the Main Plaza and its Church, where the Dominican monks built a chapel in the year 1544 and today this Chapel is the sanctuary of the Virgin of Candelaria. We will drive to Yanahuara; where we will visit the popular market of Antiquilla, that until today keep the colonial building style of the "Old Arequipa" and Yanahuara Main Plaza, having a wonderful view of the city and its volcanoes and exploring some traditional streets. After Yanahuara the tour continue along the Arequipa Main Square where you guide will give information about history and details of its infrastructure, and important points about the Cathedral. The tour will finish taking you to the entrance of Monastery of Santa Catalina. (On request the tour can finish also in Main Plaza). In the Monastery of Santa Catalina the convent guides provide the assistance for the visit to the Monument.

## Day 2

### COLCA CANYON TOUR

Breakfast at the Hotel. 8:00 A.M. We left the city of Arequipa taking the north route towards Yura, on the route we pass over the National Reserve of Salinas and Aguada Blanca; we will observe vicunas, llamas and alpacas in its wild environment, in Pampa Cañahuas we can appreciate different types of birds like the Eagles of the Andes "Kara-Kara"; Then we arrive at Mirador de los Andes where we will have a privileged view of snow-covered mountains in Patapampa (4800 m.-15 000pies). Arrival to Chivay, the capital of the valley. Accomodation at the hotel. In the afternoon as an option we can visit the hot springs t of "La Calera" that are at a temperature of 40 ° and whose waters have medicinal properties. (Entrance to the thermal baths not included, approx. \$3 per person). Accommodation in Chivay.

## Day 3

### COLCA CANYON / CRUZ DEL CONDOR AREQUIPA / LIMA

06:00 Am. Breakfast at the hotel. Very early we are ready to go to the Cross of the Condor, viewpoint from where you can appreciate the magnitude of the Colca Canyon and the spectacular flight of the condors; returning to Chivay you will visit the Mirador de Chilina, where you will find the famous hanging tombs, the Town of Yanque, its beautiful Church and its characteristic streets built of carved stone.

Arrival to Arequipa and immediately, transfer to the Airport for your return to Lima.

## Day 1

### CITY TOUR

Arrival and transfer to your Hotel. In the afternoon we start the tour driving towards to the district of Cayma, one of Arequipa's traditional districts. We will drive to Yanahuara; until today keep the colonial style of the "Old Arequipa" and the Yanahuara Main Plaza, sometimes flamencos. We will pass and its volcanoes and exploring some traditional streets. After Yanahuara we keep forward to Arequipa Main Square (Plaza de armas) where you guide will give information about history and details of its infrastructure, and important points about the Cathedral. Our tour will finish taking you to the entrance of Monastery of Santa Catalina. (On request the tour can finish also in Main Plaza). In Monastery Santa Catalina your guide will provide assistance for whoever wants to visit the Monument.

### AREQUIPA - CHIVAY

Pick up from your Hotel in Arequipa between 07:45 - 08:00 am. We begin the trip to one of the deepest Canyons of the world, bordering the snow-covered Chachani mountain towards Cañahuas Pampas. At Toca lake we will be able to appreciate a variety of migratory birds, sometimes flamencos. We will pass the crater of an extinct volcano (Chucura) and then stop at the famous volcanos panoramic viewpoint, at a high 4.800 m. From here we will appreciate, the Pre-Inca farming Terraces / platforms know as "andenerias". Approximately 13:30, Arrival to Chivay and stop for Lunch (not taking you to the entrance of Monastery of Santa Catalina. (On request the tour can finish also in Main Plaza). In Monastery Santa Catalina your guide will provide assistance for whoever wants to visit the Monument.

## Day 3

### CHIVAY - CRUZ DEL CONDOR

Early breakfast, we continue at 06:30 towards the view-point called "Cruz del Cóndor" some 1.5 hour drive into this National Park with beautiful views of the Colca Canyon. This is also the place where you should be able to observe several flying condors, sometimes passing very close to you (up to a few meters). Just near this area your tour guide will show you the Pre-inca tombs hanging in the mountains. Plenty of time to enjoy the amazing views that this place offer. On the return we will stop in the towns of Maca and Yanque, with their beautiful colonial churches, as well as in the viewpoints of Choquetico and Antahuilque, from where we will observe impressive andeneria farming platforms of the valley, and tombs in pre-Incas scale models. Lunch at 13:00 then Return and Arrival to the City of Arequipa 17:00 to 18:00 Hrs.

## Day 4

### AREQUIPA

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport where you will board your flight to your next destination. Below is the optional tour that you can choose for your last day depending on your flight time. Explore the Arequipa countryside, discover Chilina. Get panoramic views of the city from Mirador de Sachaca and cross the Iron Bridge before returning to the city at the end of the day. Start your tour with a pick up from your hotel, then travel through the valley of Chilina, Continue the tour by visiting the mill Sabandia, stone mill built in the year 1785; afterwards visit to one of the most traditional houses in the region, La Mansion del Fundador. Transfer to the airport.

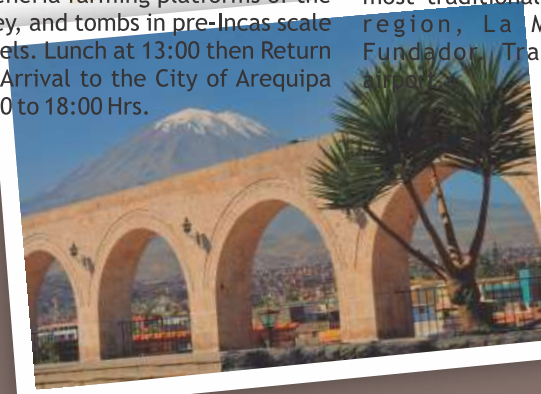

## Day 1

### LIMA - CUSCO

Transfer to the airport; arrival and transfer to the hotel. Morning at leisure to acclimate.  
14:00 P.M. Half day tour visiting the most interesting spots on the city: the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, the Inca fountain and Temple of Tambomachay, the Puca-Pucara labyrinth and the Kenko amphitheatre, then the tour will continue towards The Main Square, visiting The Cathedral with its magnificent chapels and cloister and paintings of the Cuzqueña School and then on to the Korikancha Temple, Return to the hotel. This is the traditional scheduled tour, performed in SIC (seating in car) service.

## Day 2

### CUSCO - MACHU PICCHU

Full day tour to Machu Picchu, Wonder of the New World; the 4 hours journey goes downwards the Urubamba Canyon from Poroy, the train station located at some 10 KM from Cusco. After the arrival to Aguas Calientes the journey will continue by bus to Machu Picchu. The tour begins passing through the Viewpoint, the Main Plaza and Temple of the Three Windows, the Intihuatana, the Acllawasi and other spots of this amazing Citadel. Time for a buffet lunch break and then return to Cusco by train, arrival and transfer to your hotel.

## Day 3

### CUSCO - LIMA

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport, depart to Lima. Arrival, meeting and transfer to your Hotel or stay at the airport for your next flight connection.

### LIMA - CUSCO

Continue towards the northern to visit Ollantaytambo, a fortress built during the Inca Empire, excellent sample of military architecture. At 19:00 depart to Aguas Calientes by train and overnight. Walking transfer to your hotel; this tour is available every day. Optional: the best way to do this tour is by a private service.

## Day 3

### MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO

Breakfast. The day begin with a short walking transfer to the bus station to ascend to the lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu. Your guide gave you the instructions the ight before, he will meet you at the hotel and transfer to the bus stop. After 35 minutes drive arrive at the main gate in Machu Picchu and start the tour to the incredible Inca Citadel. The tour continues roving the Lookout, the Main Plaza and Temple of the Three Windows, the Acllawasi and other spots of the amazing Citadel considered among the 7 Wonders of the Modern World. Time for a buffet lunch breake in Aguas Calientes. Return to Cusco and transfer to your selected hotel in Cusco.

## Day 4

### CUSCO - LIMA

Breakfast. Free morning in Cusco for leisure. At proper time transfer to Cusco airport to board your return flight to Lima. Upon your arrival, international connection or transfer to your hotel.

## Day 1

### LIMA - CUSCO

Transfer to the airport; arrival meeting with your guide and transfer to the hotel. After the introduction lecture the rest of then day is free for leisure and to acclimate. This is our most popular trek and offers visitors the most economical method to trek the Inca Trail to Machu Picchu. A pool service is basically a group that you can just join. You'll be trekking with like-minded hikers from all over the world, a great chance to meet new friends and travel companions. The Inca Trail is Peru's best known hike and perhaps in the World too. This 43km trek combines visits to archaeological sites, amazing mountain scenery and lush cloud forest rich in native plants such as

## Day 2

### Day 1 KM 82- WAYLLABAMBA

At 8:00 we will pick you up from the hotel and transfer to Piskacuchu (2700m), a small community located at 82 KM along the railroad from Cusco to Machu Picchu. Hikers cross the Vilcanota River and follow the trail to the right as it climbs steeply up from the river. After passing the village of Miskay, the ruins of the Inca hill fort of Huillca Raccay come into view high above the mouth of the river Cusichaca. It is a simple descent down to the Cusichaca River; there are great views of the Urubamba Range and the peak of the Mt. Veronica. You'll also get a great view over the extensive Inca ruins of Llactapata. This is the last place along the trek that you can buy snacks and drinks. Camp is set here.

## Day 3

### WAYLLABAMBA-PACAMAYO

At 6:00 you will leave Wayllabamba behind and begin the most difficult part of the trek. Following the left bank of the Llulluchayoc River for about 1 hour brings you to 'Tres Piedras' and a small bridge over the Huayruru river. A further three hours trek through steepening woods and increasingly spectacular terrain brings you to the tree line and a meadow known as Llulluchapampa (3,680m). It is another 1½ hours climb to the first and highest pass of the trail the Huarmihuañusca Pass at 4,200m. Once in the top hikers can celebrate having completed the most difficult section of the trail. The descent from the pass is steep although not difficult, following the trail on the left side of the valley to the valley floor and to the 2nd night's campsite at Pacamayo (3,600m).

## Day 4

### PACAMAYO-WIÑAY HUAYNA

This day is the longest but also the most impressive and most interesting due to the many Inca ruins that we will visit along the way. From the campsite at Pacamayo it takes about an hour to climb up to the ruins of Runkuracay (3800m). Another 45 minute hike will bring you to the top of the second pass: Abra de Runkuracay (4,000m). At last you'll feel that you are walking along the trail of the Incas with paving, for the most part, being original. This section of the trail, up till the 3rd pass, is particularly beautiful as the path crosses high stone embankments and skirts deep precipices. A few minutes after the pass is Phuyupatamarca, the most impressive Inca ruin so far. Campsite is set here.

## Day 5

### WIÑAY HUAYNA - MACHU PICCHU

We are back on the trail at 5.15am to get to Machu Picchu before sunrise. The sky starts getting light by 5:30am and the first rays of the sun hits Machu Picchu at about 7:00am. The trail contours a mountainside and drops into cloudforest before coming to an almost vertical flight of 50 steps leading up to the final pass at Inti Punku (Sun Gate). From this point you will be able to see the sunrise over Machu Picchu which is spread out before, an unforgettable experience. With just your backpack on the group will re-enter the ruins with the same guide for a complete tour of the major sectors. The tour takes about 2 hours so by about 10:30 you'll have free time to explore the ruins alone. Return by train to Cusco at 16:30.

## Day 6

### CUSCO - LIMA

Breakfast. Free morning in Cusco for leisure. At proper time transfer to Cusco airport to board your return flight to Lima. Upon your arrival, international connection or transfer to your hotel.

#### OPTIONAL:

Train or bus journey to the Lake Titicaca.

#### MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**HOW DIFFICULT IS THE TRAIL** The Inca Trail is considered a moderate hike. It's not a technical hike but there are a lot of Inca staircases to walk up and down, and the altitude may affect some individuals. We recommend purchasing a wooden walking stick while in Peru as it will help with your balance and reduce the load on your knees.

## Faq's

### IS ALTITUDE SICKNESS COMMON?

It's impossible to predict who will be affected by altitude. Your ability to adapt to high altitude is determined by your genetic makeup and has little to do with fitness or health. Most people will have no problems as long as they take the time to acclimatize properly. A full day spent in Cuzco (3249m), taking it easy and drinking plenty of water, usually enough for most people. The highest point you will reach while hiking the Inca Trail is 4200 meters. You will sleep at 3600 meters for one or two nights.

### DO PORTERS CARRY OUR LUGGAGE?

No! You will be advised to carry a small backpack which you can place up to 7kg of personal items.

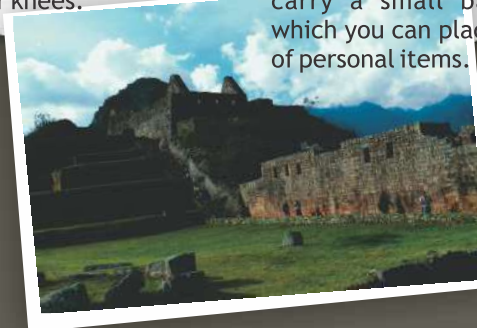

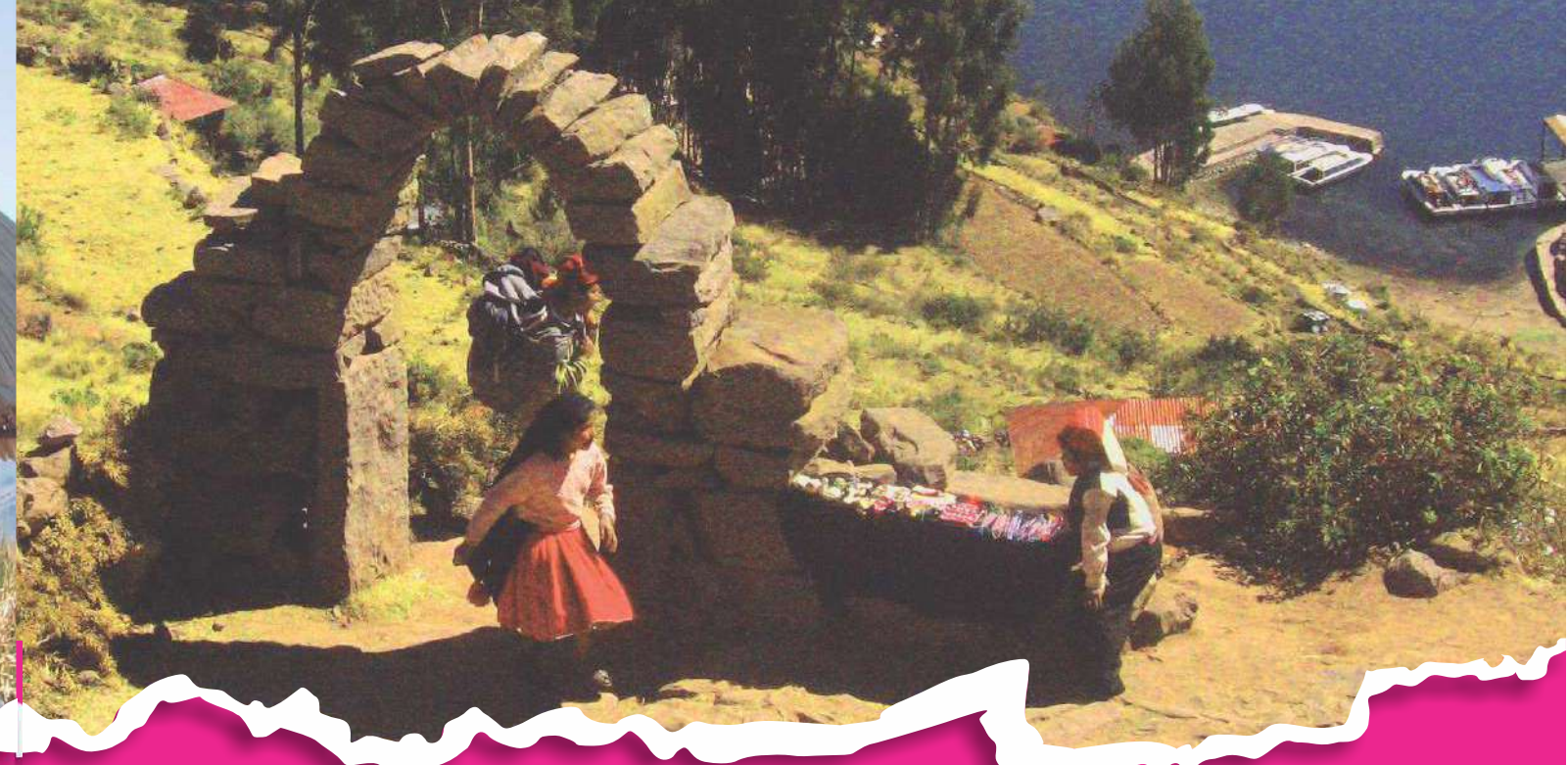

## Day 1

### PUNO - SILLUSTANI

Arrival, reception and transfer to the hotel. Based on time of arrival we visit to the Sillustani archaeological center which is located 34 km. from the city of Puno, or if your arrival is programmed for the evening, we can perform this tour on the way to the airport the last day. On the way to Puno, if your arrival is by flight, the drive from the airport in Juliaca, at some 70 KM, one can see the great extension and the beauty of the landscape in the highland, being witness to the flourishing of ancient cultures; Sillustani is one of the largest necropolises in America, its esplanade is located at about 4000m, at the shape of a peninsula which leans on the beautiful and mysterious Lake Umayo, the contrast of the intense blue of the sky with the landscape is simply awesome.

Later you will visit the island of Taquile, located 20km east of the Uros, where you will see the customs of the inhabitants in constant contact with nature, which stand out for their crafts and typical dress. We will be witnesses of their customs and traditions, which remain unchanged; lunch is served in one of the Islanders home. There are two possibilities to climb to the town: the first is for people that like to make physical effort, in this case you have to upload the island by 533 steps to reach the entrance arch and descend towards the Plaza Mayor; the second is a soft slope leading to the village, takes approximately 1 hour; at the afternoon return to Puno, arrival and transfer to the hotel.

## Day 3

### AMANTANI

Breakfast at Amantani and this day the fun will continue, after the typical breakfast based in fruits and quinoa; you sail up to the Taquile Island; there are two possibilities to climb to the town: the first is for those who likes hiking, in this case you have to upload the island by 533 steps to reach the entrance arch and descend towards the Plaza Mayor; the second is a soft slope leading to the village, takes approximately 1 hour; at the afternoon return to Puno, arrival and transfer to the hotel. Taquile has a magnificent views of the lake and its bucolic atmosphaera contagious the peace. Lunch is served in one of the taquilenos home. Time to relax and enjoy the stillnes. Sail back to Puno and transfer to the hotel.

## Day 4

### PUNO

Breakfast at the hotel. For those who has arrived in Puno at evening during the first day this will be the opportunity to visit Sillustani and the lake Umayo. At proper time begins the tour and at the end transfer to the airport or bus terminal.
